

Safeguarding children awareness



The importance of safeguarding children cannot be over-emphasised. All organisations with staff/volunteers who have contact with families, children or carers must develop a systemic awareness of the key issues, responsibilities and boundaries and embed this understanding in their service delivery.

This course is for all staff/volunteers whose work brings them directly into contact with children, families or carers, and for managers and team leaders responsible for supervising and supporting in their day-to-day work.

This course focuses on:

- The impact of the Children Act 2004 and the statutory guidance
- The signs and symptoms of abuse in children
- The potential behaviour indicators associated with different forms of abuse
- Examples of family circumstances in which risks most commonly arise
- How to respond professionally and appropriately to a disclosure of abuse
- Keeping and maintaining confidential records.
