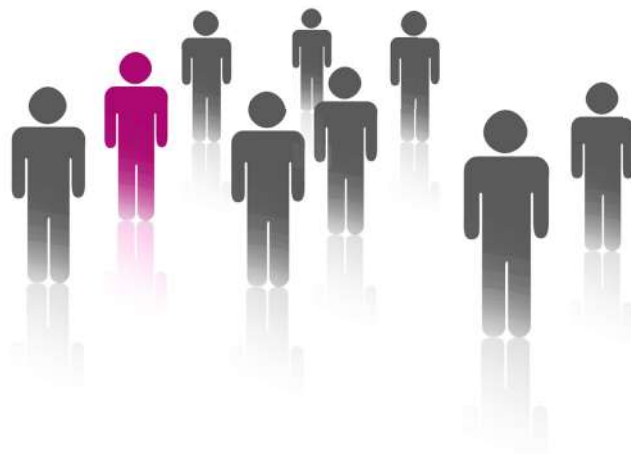


Equality and diversity for voluntary and community groups
